

CALCULATION OF THE GRADE TRANSCRIPT AND RESUMED CURRICULUM VITAE SCORE FOR CLASSIFICATION IN THE SELECTION PROCESS

PHASE 1 - Evaluation of the Grade Transcript and Documented Resumed Curriculum Vitae (maximum score 70 points). The candidate who obtains a score equal to or greater than 35 (thirty-five) points (50%) in the evaluation of the Curriculum and Grade Transcript will be approved for the next phase (Phase 2), with candidates scoring less than 35 points being eliminated.
